SWEATCON 17 BROKEN HERO

Every 'hero' of the faith points to the one who was pierced, crushed and broken for us. At SWEATCON17 we will fix our eyes on Jesus as we are equipped for ministry and evangelism from Sydney's South West to the ends of the earth.

WHAT IS SWEATCON?

SWEATCON is a training conference in the South-West (SW) of Sydney. It is in the SW, for the SW, by the SW. The conference seeks to train up leaders and future leaders in the churches of the SW. It also seeks to encourage local people in their ministries and to stay in the SW for the sake of the gospel. It's suitable for church leaders, Bible study leaders, Sunday school teachers, scripture teachers, youth leaders – young or old, male or female - basically anyone who is serving God's people.

WHY ANOTHER CONFERENCE AND WHY IN THE SOUTH WEST?

The SW of Sydney has some unique challenges: it is the most multicultural area of Sydney; there are many social and financial pressures; and we are aware of many churches struggling with no ministers and/or no leadership training. This conference is geared to people in the SW - you don't need a university education to soak up the training and it is very affordable.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN AT THE CONFERENCE?

Tom Habib will start the first session with a Bible talk. In the afternoon we have Training Strand Groups, followed by skills-based practical workshops. You will also hear from a variety of people regarding ministries in the SW and there will be plenty of breaks to talk and network. The night session will include a Bible talk by Al Stewart. All night sessions are FREE for anyone in the SW to attend.
